These 7 scholarships are for students specifically planning on majoring in a field of Technology (Engineering, Manufacturing, Architecture, Computer Related, etc. in any college or vocational school including Technology Teacher Education).

2. Cap Membership. The dues for this option will be \$650.00.
3. Late Fee if uploaded and submitted to www.tsaweb.org after November 15, 2009 will be \$25.00.
4. Texas Chapter Fee (Registration Fee for State Contest) will be \$25.00. **Please include your registration fee for State Contest with your online affiliation.**
5. **Your chapter affiliation must be done online at www.tsaweb.org. This must be uploaded and submitted no later than November 15, 2009 to avoid the \$25.00 late fee.**
