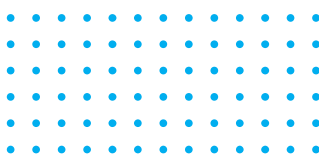

Scholarship Application Guidelines

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Applicants must:

- Be a registered student in a TSA Chapter
- Be currently enrolled in high school and scheduled to graduate at the end of the current academic year
- Have competed in a TSA Competition any year of their high school career
- Be in good academic standing
- Have passed the TSIA (Texas Success Initiative Assessment)
- Plan to attend an accredited college, university or technology center and have a declared major in a STEM related field.
- Be only one of two chapter members per Chapter recommended for scholarship.

Additional Information:

- All scholarship award payments will be sent to the scholarship recipient by September 1 after receiving proof of enrollment from the scholarship recipient.
- Awards are based on years of TSA involvement, academic potential, achievement, recommendation and the student's personal essay.
- Applicants must meet all minimum enrollment qualifications required by the university/college/tech center.
- Completed applications must include a student resume and an essay response as defined in the scholarship application.
- All applications must include a photo of the applicant to be used in newsletter/social media.

DEADLINE & APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications and all supporting documentations, including letters of recommendation, must be received by the posted deadlines below. Incomplete applications WILL NOT be considered.

- Student Application Deadline - February 21, 2026 by 11:59 PM CST
- Chapter Advisor Evaluation & School Official Evaluation Deadline - March 1, 2026 by 11:59 PM CST
